Want to make a difference? Be heard!

Within 3 weeks we will have results to hand for the next Federal Election. We have heard little from either of the major parties with regards to conservation or the environment. Each of our local candidates needs to be made aware of where you stand. If you are a voter make yourself heard, campaign for the environment at every opportunity you get.

Our Queensland State Government has announced an additional \$12.1 million over four years and an ongoing commitment to another \$2.6 million per year for koala protection. We have also entered the preliminary phase for preparation of a new planning regime for South East Queensland. Your local member of Parliament needs to be reminded of the value of our Natural Heritage in future planning decisions.

At a local level the demolition of the former Amcor site at Petrie is continuing and the opening of Moreton Bay Rail Link has been placed on hold indefinitely. There is a concerted push from some members of the community for the koala population on the Amcor site to be subject to a translocation program, with a specific emphasis on the koalas being moved to Laceys Creek.
